Menai Strait Regattas 2018

The Menai Strait Regattas 2018 will consist of 12 individual regattas, one race each day hosted by a different club or committee.

The Regattas start on Monday 30th July 2018 and finish on Saturday 11th August 2018

The event is organised by the Menai Strait Combined Regatta Committee on behalf of the individual host clubs and committees.

Racing each day starts at one of 4 venues along the Menai Strait between Beaumaris and Caernarfon.

2 Eligibility and Entry

Late Entry fees apply after 15th July 2018. Late entries may be handed in until the day preceding the race at the Regatta Office (when open) or completed at the start line on the day of the race up to 1 hour before the start of the race.

Entry Fees are not refundable in the event of a race being abandoned and not resailed

- 3.2 Mooring fees:
Moorings for boats can be booked using the Entry Form or by emailing your requirements to secretary@menaistraitregattas.org.uk. Mooring fees for Mylne, Hilbre, Conway, Squib, Star & Opera classes are £75 for the complete regatta period. Mooring fees for other classes are available by negotiation.
- 3.3 Car Parking:
Car passes for parking on Beaumaris Green are available either using the Regattas Entry Form or at the Regattas Office in the Royal Anglesey Yacht Club during the event. The car passes are valid for one week. If 2 or more regattas are entered in a week then the entry will be entitled to one free car pass for that week. Extra passes are available for £5 per week if required. Card to operate the barrier may be borrowed in exchange for a refundable deposit of £xx
- 3.4 **Fees should be paid using the on line banking details shown on the entry form or by sending a cheque with the entry form. Payment may also be made at the Regattas Office or at the start line on the day.**

5 **Sailing Instruction**

6 **Courses**

Courses will be chosen by the Race Officer each day to take account of the local weather and tidal conditions and displayed at the start line.

Courses for Classes 1 to 13 will usually be chosen from the Marks and Courses booklet or may on occasion follow the "X course" procedure shown in the Sailing Instructions on the Beaumaris Marks and Courses page.

Courses for Classes 14 & 15 will be available each day when signing on at the start line.

Some classes will also be awarded prizes for the results of the first and/or second week's racing and in some classes other prizes will be awarded for specific groups of races and/or specific achievements.

10 Risk Statement

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore, and will carry adequate lifesaving equipment for all persons on board;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regattas.

11 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
